

# MAINTENANCE

Marble	<p>Marble is a metamorphic rock mainly made up of calcium carbonate. Despite being considered “eternal” because it resists knocks and abrasion, marble is very porous and sensitive to stains and acids. This is why it is important to care for it as soon as it is laid, cleaning it with neutral detergents and treating it with specific stain protectors. The best cleaning, protection and maintenance treatment is to use specific products such as FILAREFRESH of FILA (Padova - Italy) : used on a daily basis, it cleans surfaces and reinforces stain-proofing protection.</p> <p>Certified as safe for food preparation areas. <a href="http://www.filasolutions.com">www.filasolutions.com</a></p>
Slate	<p>Slate is a particular variety of sedimentary-origin metamorphic rock that is mainly black or grey, can also be found in green, burgundy or multi-colour versions. It is a very strong, compact stone, highly resistant to the elements and wear and naturally waterproof. Slate from Italy contains a significant amount of calcium carbonate and is therefore sensitive to acid washes, which tend to turn the material grey.</p> <p>The best cleaning, protection and maintenance treatment is to use specific products such as FILAREFRESH of FILA (Padova - Italy) : used on a daily basis, it cleans surfaces and reinforces stain-proofing protection.</p> <p>Certified as safe for food preparation areas. <a href="http://www.filasolutions.com">www.filasolutions.com</a></p>
Wood	<p>In the painted wood, more hands of paints are applied that close the porosity of the material by creating a transparent and shiny film. Painted wood therefore does not need protective treatments.</p> <p>We recommend maintenance with neutral products.</p>
Steel	<p>Use non aggressive cleaning products. Do not use abrasive cloths that can scratch the surface especially if painted.</p>
